Introducing the New Beginnings Rescue Ranch!



We are very excited to announce the completion of our New Beginnings Rescue Ranch, located in Delton, MI! This project has been over a year in the making and this winter we will be able to welcome dogs to this state of the art facility! The building is temperature controlled for the hot summers as well as the cold Michigan winters. There are 10 kennels that will be primarily used as single kennels, but are large enough to hold 2 dogs each. 2 family sized kennels are also available for pregnant females or litters of puppies. Each kennel is equipped with an outdoor area accessed by doggy door.



The facility has a storage room for crates, feed room, kitchen and bathroom. Shower and bathing area for the dogs. There will also be a living room type area where volunteers can spend time with dogs and they can have access to cozy couches.



The facility is designed to accommodate up to 25 sporting dogs. This space will serve as a temporary safe and welcoming environment for dogs beginning their journey (or in transit) to their forever homes.


Embark Partnership

Fi Partnership


This Fi offer is open to all of our supporters and volunteers!
